

Regularly Scheduled Series Activity Fee

Regularly Schedule Series (RSS) are grand rounds, case conferences, tumor boards, M&M conferences, and journal clubs. These are live CME activities less than 2 credit hours in length, have a series of multiple sessions, occur on an ongoing basis, and are primarily planned by and presented to a department.

Frequency	Yearly Accreditation Fee
Less than Monthly	\$1000
≥ Monthly	\$1200
≤ Weekly	\$1500
More than Weekly	\$2000

Streaming of an RSS: If you stream live an RSS there is no additional cost for awarding credit to those watching live. If you want to record your RSS activity and make it available to learners for subsequent viewing, reference Online Enduring Materials Activity Fee.

Online Enduring Materials Activity Fee

Enduring Materials (EM) and Internet Enduring Materials (IEM) are physician self-study activities that may be used over a period of time. These are typically printed, recorded, or computer-assisted instructional materials such as audio and video files, podcasts, interactive and web-based learning modules, which may be used either alone or in combination with written materials for independent learning by physicians.

Number of Activities	Accreditation Fee
1-3 Activities	\$500
4-10 Activities	\$1500
11-20 Activities	\$2000
21-50 Activities	\$3000
51-100 Activities	\$4000
>100 Activities	\$4000 plus \$50 per activity

Additional costs may apply if the audience is greater than 500 for a single activity.

Enduring RSS Archive: We will award credit for up to 4 of your RSS recordings per activity annually at no additional cost. Beyond 4, you will incur an additional fee. ACCME rules require us to have a post test for each enduring activity. As a result, the work is significantly greater to award credit for non-live activities. If you seek to record your RSS activities and make them endure for CME credit the cost is double our normal RSS fee. Further, prior to doing this there is an expectation that you can demonstrate a sufficient market to warrant the additional work involved.

Internet Live Webinars and Webcasts Activity Fee

An Internet Live (IL) activity is an online course available at a certain time on a certain date and is only available in real-time, just as if it were a course held in an auditorium. Once the event has taken place, learners may no longer participate in that activity.

13-20 Activities	\$2000

Additional costs of \$10 per learner will apply if the audience is greater than 100 for a single activity.
